UAUT/UATC Media Challenge 2025

Hosted by: United African University of Tanzania (UAUT) & United African Technical College (UATC)

In preparation for the launch of the *Diploma in Journalism & Media Production* program at the United African Technical College (UATC), we will host a comprehensive media competition targeting students interested in journalism, media production, and filmmaking.

Target Participants:

Form four and form six students, local people having all qualifications to study diploma in media and journalism as well as students having certificates in any related program.

Competition Categories

1. News Writing

- Theme: Untold Stories of My Community
- **Format**: Participants will write a news article of up to 1,000 characters based on a hidden or overlooked story from their local community.
- Evaluation Criteria: Authenticity, structure, writing skills
- **Highlights**: Comprehensive assessment of story planning, interviewing, filming, and editing skills

2. Voice of the Future (News Anchor Competition)

- Theme: The Past and Future of Tanzania's Tourism Industry through the Eyes of Youth
- **Format**: Participants will write and present a video news script within 3 minutes. Submissions will be pre-recorded; finalists will present live on-site.
- **Evaluation Criteria**: Depth of content, visual quality, pronunciation, delivery skills, facial expression, gestures, and on-camera demeanor
- Highlights: Strengthening news presentation and media performance abilities

3. Short Film Production

- Theme: The Beginning of Change
- Format: Production of a short film under 5 minutes
- Evaluation Criteria: Creativity, storytelling, technical quality
- Highlights: Discovering creative media and filmmaking talents

4. Creative Media Writing Challenge

- Theme: The World Transformed by Social Media or Truth and Falsehood in the Digital Age
- Format: Writing a creative and logical article or column
- Evaluation Criteria: Creativity, storytelling ability, media ethics, technical excellence
- **Highlights**: Emphasis on both journalism and creativity; outstanding works will be posted and promoted on UAUT/UATC media platforms

5. Photojournalism

- Theme: Stories Around Us
- **Format**: Submission of 5 photos with a brief description for each (maximum 100 characters per description)
- Evaluation Criteria: Expression of the theme, photo quality, clarity of descriptions
- Highlights: Enhancing creativity and critical thinking skills

- Judging Period: September 1, 2025 September 6, 2025
- Results Announcement: Sept 10, 2025
- Award Ceremony and Exhibition: Sept 10, 2025, at UAUT Campus
